CNK & RUSD Extended Learning Hours

Cops 'N Kids encourages the love of reading through hands-on, funfilled education. Our staff is composed of retired and current teachers who educate students. Our goal is to provide a positive learning environment for the children who attend. All of our learning services are free to children ages two through sixth grade.

Our classroom activities stress reading, writing, and language along with listening, completing assigned tasks, transitioning, cooperating, making nutritional food choices, and attending on a regular basis. Occasionally art and music programming is also incorporated into classes. Community Police Officers visit each group of children to read books and engage children in conversation to build good relationships. It is our goal to have the children transfer these important life skills to home, respecting yourself and each other, school and community activities.
